**A Non-voting member** is a processor, wholesaler, exporter, or a person who has less than 50 feijoa trees or intends to plant feijoa trees.

### 4. COMMODITY LEVY

All commercial growers of feijoas are bound to pay a commodity levy, currently at the rate of 3% of the price of feijoas sold in New Zealand at the first point of sale or 3% of the fob value for export feijoas or 3% of the unprocessed value of feijoas if a grower processes the feijoas on their own account. All prices are exclusive of GST. The levy is normally deducted from growers' returns and paid to the Association by the purchaser. Further information on the Feijoa Commodity Levy Order is available from the Association.

### 5. PAYMENT DETAILS

The Membership application fee for new members (voting and non-voting memberships) is \$140.00 including GST. This fee includes the membership pack, and membership through to the end of the current membership year.
